UNITY COLLEGE PARENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

The feedback from Parents is an important measure for the college to evaluate its service provision and thus cater to providing excellent service towards the students.

For the academic year 2022-23, the parents of UG 3rd and 5th semesters were asked to complete a feedback form to gain insight into how the college could improve on various parameters. The link to the form was dispatched through the IQAC while the mentors took prompt initiatives to ensure timely return of the duly filled form (statistics provided below). The college value feedback and treat it with highest respect, courtesy, value and confidentiality.

Objectives

- 1. To provide a platform to the parents to comment on the quality of their ward's learning experience.
- 2. To assess the success of academic provision in relation to the expectations of both the parents and the students.
- 3. To provide feedback to the faculties in order to improve delivery and/or content of the curriculum.

Area of focus

The feedback questionnaire was constructed based on six aspects,

- 1. Curricular aspects
- 2. Co-curricular aspect
- 3. Student-teacher relationship
- 4. Infrastructural facilities
- 5. Administration
- 6. Overall development of the students








Figure 3 depict parents' opinion regarding admission procedure of the college. Basing on the responses, it can be seen that the parents are satisfied with the procedure with an overall average of 83.4% positive response as against 16.5% negative response.

Teaching-learning process (student centric, experimental, participatory etc.) 157 responses




Figure 4 depict the data on teaching-learning process. Overall average percentage of 90.4% respondents expressed positive opinion while only 9.5% expressed negative opinion.



Transparency in the assessment/evaluation methodologies 157 responses










Co-curricular activities (sports, cultural, literary and other activities for students)




Exposure of students to career orientation and placement opportunities 157 responses


Use/availability of Information and communication technology in the college 157 responses

With regard to teaching learning support and facilities (**fig.14**) majority of parents (80%) had positive opinion. However, the data also depicts an average of 20% negative response. This shows that the particular aspect can be improved. For which, the management can undertake necessary action.





Figure 15 depict the parents' opinion on additional physical facilities such as transportation, canteen, playground, multi-purpose halls etc., it is seen that an overall average of 66% had positive opinion. However, it is also observed that there is an average of 34% negative response with an independent response percentage of 19.7% Fair and 14% Poor. This indicates that there is serious issue/concern on this aspect. The management can undertake necessary measure on the regard.

Support from academic / administrative official for discussions / clarifications 157 responses



In the area of academic and administrative support with regard to discussions/clarifications of doubts and issues from the office to the parents (**fig. 16**), it is indicated that an average of 74% parents had positive opinion. However, an overall average percentage of 26% had negative opinion with an independent percentage of 20% responding Fair. This aspect can be improved for better communication and ultimately better relationship between the college and the parents/guardians.

Academic as well as personal growth of ward since joining the college 157 responses



- 6. Support from academic / administrative official for discussions / clarifications

Additional suggestions from the parents:

- 1. Increase the number of transportation facility in accordance with the enrollment
- 2. Need for auditorium/ multipurpose hall
- 3. Provision of ICT enabled classroom/ smart classrooms
- 4. Improve Student- teacher ratio
- 5. Provision of indoor/outdoor sports space/facilities
- 6. Organize Orientation programs for the parents supplemented by periodic newsletters, email updates or workshops on relevant topics such as financial aid, academic progress, and career guidance.
