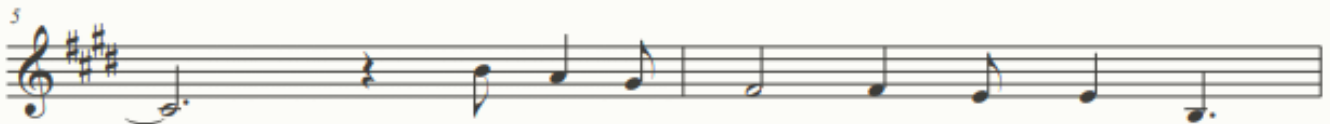

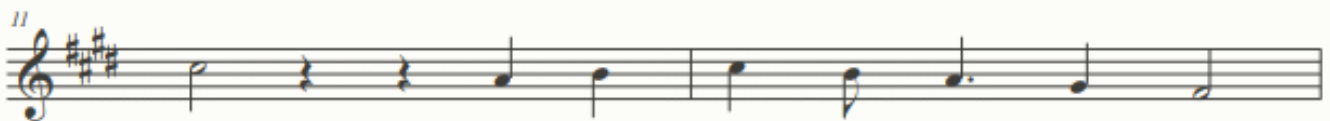

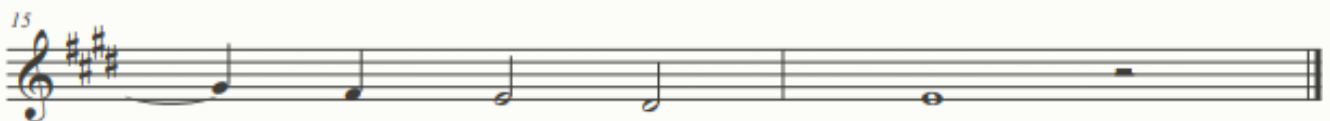

## CURRICULUM AND FRAMEWORK CREDIT FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (NEP-2020)

### ELIGIBILITY FOR THE UG PROGRAMMES

Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary (12th Grade) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education corresponding to Level-4 and as per Nagaland University guidelines.

### DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

- i. The duration of the UG programme is 4 years or 8 semesters. Students who desire to undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be allowed to exit after completion of the 3rd year. If a student wants to leave after the completion of the first or second year, the student will be given a UG Certificate or UG Diploma, respectively, provided they secure the prescribed number of credits (as given in table 3). Students who exit with a UG certificate or UG diploma are permitted to re-enter within three years and complete the degree programme.
- ii. Students may be permitted to take a break from the study during the period of study but the total duration for completing the programme shall not exceed 7 years.

## ADMISSION

Nagaland University offers equal educational opportunities to all qualified persons, provided the candidate fulfills all the conditions. Eligible students for Major streams (internally or externally) will be given preference over General stream.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must have passed Three-year Degree Course with Honours with 50% marks and for General stream students with 55% in the concerned subjects in which admission is sought.

5% marks relaxation for SC/ST category will be considered.

The applicants who have graduated from Colleges (Private/Govt./Autonomous) affiliated to Nagaland University shall be entitled to 10% weightage of Bonus marks over others. For instance, a candidate who passed out from any college affiliated to Nagaland University with 60% marks in graduation will get 6% as additional weightage and his/her total percentage will become 66% while drawing the merit index of selection.

Application will not be considered for admission to two or more Departments concurrently.

The number of seats available for admission to M.Com will depend upon seats authorized by the University.

The distribution of seats in the Masters Programmes in the College shall be as follows:-

- Open/General category -40%
- SC/ST category -50%
- Management Quota -10%

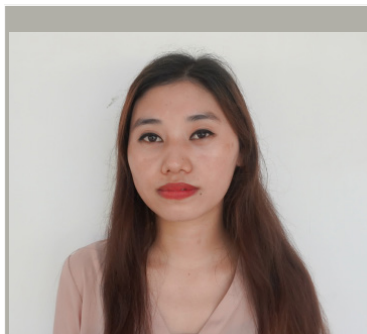

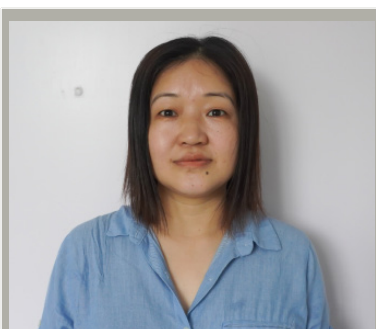

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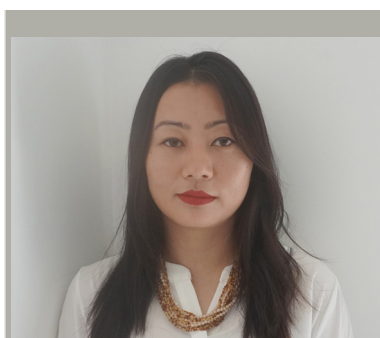
