**Action Taken Report on the decisions of the IQAC meeting held on 20/08/2022**

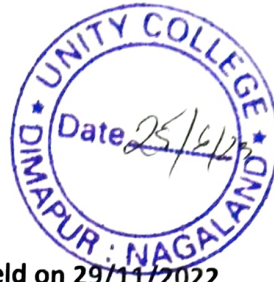
In Pursuance of the decisions of the above-mentioned meeting of the IQAC, the following actions were taken:


**Action Taken Report on the decisions of the IQAC meeting held on 14/02/2023**


### Action Taken Report on the decisions of the IQAC meeting held on 6/03/2023


### **Action Taken Report on the decisions of the IQAC meeting held on 10/05/2023**
