
ACTION TAKEN/OUTCOME REPORT 2020-2021



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



2. Mr. Rajan Thakur Kumar, Vice Principal, Unity College and Mr. P.S. Gladson, Librarian were added as new IQAC Members.



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

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
Action Taken Report on the decision of the IQAC meeting held on 03/12/2020

Due to lockdown the decisions of the above two IQAC meetings could not be implemented.


