- 4. (a) What is the main theme of Johnson's London and how does it reflect the poet's views on the city?

- (b) How does Elegy Written in a Country Churchyard reflect on the inevitability of death?
- **5.** (a) Critically analyse the themes in Laurance Sterne's The Life and Opinions of Tristram Shandy Gentleman.

(b) Comment on the narrative style and structure of The Life and Opinions of Tristram Shandy, Gentleman.
